Ian opened his concert bemoaning his advancing years; He was feeling his age but could just claim to still be in his twenties at twenty nine. There was many an understanding groan of laughter from the audience. Ian produced an evening of great musical variety and style. His music was well played and it spanned many decades between times old and present, something to suit all tastes. Ian's humour was adlib,



off the cuff and relevant to the evening, it was appreciated by much laughter from the audience.

Ian Works for Yamaha, where he reckons he was now responsible for "everything that has black and white keys", he has been heavily involved in the Genos development. For his performance he used a Yamaha Genos keyboard, without pedalboard.
