Matthew Bason's career as a performer began in 1994; appearing at a variety of venues as both a pianist and organist. In 1994 first appearing in a solo recital at Hadlow Down, East Sussex. Mathew was both working and a student of Reading University. Mathew graduated with a B.A. (Ed) Honours degree in Music and Education in 2002. His reputation has become international; with performances in mainland Europe, U.S.A., and Canada.

At other times Mathew is teaching and performing across the U.K. In September 2015, Matthew joined a team of organists at 'The Scarborough Fair Collection'; there he entertains visitors to the museum collection on the Wurlitzer organ.

Forthcoming Concert

Kevin Grunill 24th June 2019



Kevin was born in Barnsley, South Yorkshire in 1972. From an early age he showed an interest in music, at twelve he learned to play the electronic organ progressing at sixteen to the theatre organ for which he developed a different playing style to that of his electronic organ. Kevin took to performing concerts throughout the country featuring both electronic and theatre organs and is a musician just as at home playing modern electronic instruments as traditional pipe organ and piano. Kevin continued

his musical education and studied at a performing arts college before Leeds University in 1994 where he graduated with a Bachelor of Arts (Hons) Degree in music. Kevin has performed at the Royal Festival Hall in London, The Playhouse Theatre, Weston-Super-Mare and the Opera House, the Tower Ballroom, Blackpool and Granada Television Studios Manchester. Review of our Recent Concert

15th April 2019 Peter Shaw

A low turnout audience of forty seven at Mountnessing Hall for Peter Shaw's performance. Peter had withdrawn from performing and it had been some years since he visited us, those club members who were unable to attend his concert this time missed a quite entertaining evening from an accomplished performer. Peter has a surprisingly youthful voice and during the evening used it singing a well applauded version of 'This is the moment' and Burt Baccarat's 'The look of love'. His performance at the keyboard included many styles and favourites. It must be said that he has returned to public performance with a very listenable repertoire.

Some of the music played by Peter included;
