His career has led him to perform at the Notre Dame Cathedral in Paris, playing a premiere of a jazz organ piece at the Duke's Hall, Royal Academy of Music, corporate functions and various tours of the Far East, both as a solo performer and session musician, and performances on national TV and BBC Radio 2. Chris combines a performing career with that of a music examiner for the London College of Music and that of teacher.

Age 7 at School David began learning to play the piano. At school he continued his education to an 'A' level course and subsequently a Music diploma course at college in Cambridge. His studies on the piano continued with a professor from the Royal College of Music in London and David also began training, as a singer and organist taking up the organ at age 20.

David trained in London to become a School Teacher and on completion of training became Head of Music at Littleport Village College. His career continued and he moved on to the same post at Cottenham Village College in Cambridgeshire. His performance career has lead to appearance at the London Ritz and many festivals across the UK.

David plays a Technics C800 organ, Roland SP3 piano and Technics KN7000 keyboard and accompanies himself as a singer.

Dave Smith had faced a difficult journey south to join us for the concert and had been detained behind a serious accident on the A1 fortunately he was neither involved not prevented from arriving with just enough time to setup for the concert. It is some years since David now seventy four had played for us, as with us all the passage of time brings about changes yet his performance brought a full selection of music and provided good entertainment for most. It was an enjoyable evening. David played Roland Atelier AT80R organ which gave great sounds.

An encore was called for and David provided an extended rendition of MacArthur Park met by enthusiastic applause.
