Mark Thompson



Mark's playing of the Electronic organ began at age seven. He joined the Technics Academy at nine; He worked his way through his grades whilst along the way entering local competitions and reached the area finals in 1999.

Mark was a pupil of Chiho Sunamato at the Yamaha School of Music; and was performing in

concerts by the age of fifteen. Mark then travelled the UK and abroad playing the Yamaha EL90 for organ societies, festivals and private functions.

In 2002 Mark won the 'Young Theatre Organist of the Year' competition and has subsequently performed on many of the UK's most prodigious theatre organs.

Mark also plays in a 60s and 70s band, 'Wallstreet', on keyboards and providing backing vocals, he is also the musical director or rehearsal pianist for many North East musical theatre societies. Mark's other works include that of, vocal coach, accompanist or Music Director for many North East stage schools, and musical theatre colleges in both Blackpool and Leeds.

Mark plays 'cocktail piano' at hotels and restaurants across the North East, also for weddings throughout the year. He plays with 'The Fab Dakers Boys' jazz band at Newcastle United's football ground, 'St. James' Park', and features in the 'The Ratpack Vegas Spectacular' band, for shows at theatres around the country.

Next Concert - Nicholas Martin B.E.M - 24th Oct 2023

Nick began his music career studying the piano at nine years of age. A family visit to Blackpool in 1969 (at age five), gave him the chance to hear the Wurlitzer organ being played in the famous Tower Ballroom by "Mr Blackpool" - Reginald Dixon. At the age of eleven it became his ambition to perform at this most famous of venues. Nick's ambition was achieved in 1981. He accepted a post as resident organist — and was then just 17. Nick became the resident Wurlitzer organist at "Turner's", in April 1983, and remained there until its closure in June 2004.

For his relentless and tireless support of the "Miracles to Believe in" charity, helping those with autism, Nick was awarded the B.E.M.

Last concert - The Powells 22nd Aug 2023

Quite a concert, two musicians in a simultaneous and seamless performance on stage, playing duets throughout, a first for us in a long time or perhaps ever at Brentwood.
