Chris's interest in music began aged 11 with piano, he moved on to the electronic organ at 13, by the time he was 14 he was performing for Orpington organ society and his school.

Later work found him a role as Deputy organist at the Streatham Ice rink. In 1985 Chris met David Lingwood at the first Caister Keyboard Festival, he then turned professional. He has played for many societies all over Britain and at

most major festivals.

In 1991 he worked as Showroom Manager for Wersi at their UK headquarters in Purley', in 1994 for GIG Sounds in Streatham, South London, in 1995 at Rose-Morris in the West End. In 1996 he was offered the job as Manager of Roland Friday Keyboards, but in January 1997 Roland Friday sold the retail business to Music Land. Chris continues to work for them on a part time basis with David Harrild.

Chris's musical tastes cover a broad spectrum, though he is particularly keen on Musicals, Marches, Romantic Ballads and Latin American.

Next Concert - Andrew Nix 27th Feb 2024

Andrew Nix, born 22nd August 1968 near Selby, North Yorkshire, he is both a musician and entertainer with a varied musical repertoire and Yorkshire humour. At the age of ten his interest in organs became apparent. Andrews's mother had an organ at home and he sat down and taught himself Christmas carols. His parents recognised potential and arranged lessons for him. After leaving school Andrew was offered three nights a week playing in a local club. He accompanied artistes and played for dancers. At 17 he was appointed Organist and Musical Director for a Theatre Group performing at Butlins, Barry Island. Three years later he became freelance and in demand for concerts and dances nationwide on both Theatre and Electronic organs. May 2000 Andrew changed to performing on a Roland Atelier, and now tours with the AT900c. He and a good friend Tony Stace, are trading as "Topnote Events" they host events at various venues

Quite a concert - Chris played the Yamaha ELS-02X Stagea organ, fully integrating its many orchestral sounds. He entertained with an extensive mix of pieces and a smattering of festive ones, perhaps not as many as there may have been, the audience not too excited about Christmas yet, but then it was only the 12th of December. There was much to listen to, music and humorous commentary. The pieces played drew enthusiastic audience applause and some to their feet cheering for an encore - Thunderbirds are go.
