At the age of ten his interest in organs became apparent, his

mother had an organ at home and Andrew sat down and taught himself Christmas carols. His parents recognised potential and arranged lessons for him.

After leaving school Andrew was offered three nights a week playing in a local club. He accompanied artistes and played for dances. At 17 he was appointed Organist and Musical Director for a Theatre Group performing at Butlins, Barry Island. Three years later Andrew became freelance, in demand for concerts and dances nation-wide on both Theatre and Electronic organs.

Since May 2000 Andrew has been performing on the Roland Atelier, he now tours with the AT900c.

Next Concert - Matthew Bason 16th Dec 2025

Matthew Bason's performance career commenced in 1994; he worked at a variety of venues as both a pianist and organist. His initial solo recital of 1994 was at, Hadlow Down, East Sussex.

Mathew was both working and a student of Reading University, graduating with a B.A. (Ed) Honours degree in Music and Education in 2002.

Matthews's reputation has become international; he has performed in mainland Europe, U.S.A., and Canada. The rest of his time is devoted to teaching and performing across the U.K.

Beside his organ music, Matthew is pianist in the jazz quartet "Jazz Essence" and jazz band "Lula Jazz". He is also Organist of St. Andrew's Anglican Church, Wellingborough.

Last concert - Tony Stace 28th Oct 2025

Tony's reputation is well known and a 'good concert' was anticipated. His musical prowess and humour kept all entertained. He played his nearly 40 year old Yamaha HX1, (he does have 6 more) the instrument still sounding great despite its advancing age. Tony enhanced the depth of sound with a connected Roland BK7M expander for those extra sounds and rhythms.

Usual brilliant concert from him with a wide variety of recognisable music which brought the audience at times to its feet. There was a definite call to 'encore' as the audience called – More More!!
